

DASHCAM OVERVIEW

- 1 Power Button/IR Mode
- 02 Mode/Menu Button
- 03 UP Button
- 04 Down Button
- 05 OK Button
- 06 TF Card Slot
- 07 Power Slot (USB-C)
- 08 Reset Hole
- 09 Fill Light



OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

01	POWER	The Camera: Long-press Power button for 2-3s to turn ON/OFF.		
		Infared Light: Short-press Power button to turn the infared light ON/OFF. Turn ON/OFF in working status.		
02	MENU/ MODE	Enter Menu Settings: Long-press Menu button once in non-recording status.		
		Exit the Menu Setting: Short-press on Menu button in Menu status.		
		Enter Video Playback Mode: Short-press button once in non-recording status.		
03	UP BUTTON	Short-press once to scroll UP in Menu setting.		
		Short-press once to switch the display windows of the front camera, interior (cabin) camera, and left/right camera.		
		Short-press once to scroll to previous video files in Playback mode.		
04	DOWN BUTTON	Short-press once to scroll DOWN in Menu setting.		
		Short-press once to mute Audio Recording in Video Mode.		
		Short-press once to scroll to next video files in Playback Mode.		
05	OK BUTTON	Recording: Short-press once to start/stop video recording.		
		Short-press once to play/pause current video in Playback mode.		
		Short-press once to enter/save the setting in Menu setting.		
80	RESET	Reset the Dash Cam.		
09	FILL LIGHT	Fill lights for the cabin cameras, turn it ON/OFF by short-pressing the Power button when recording.		

INSTALL FRONT CAMERA

STEP 1: MOUNTING THE ELECTROSTATIC FILM



IMPORTANT!

Before sticking on the camera, be sure to clean the windshield properly. If the glass is dirty, the bracket will not adhere and can easily fall off.

Clean the windshield glass with the cleaning accessory included in the box





Please peal off the cover marked "①", then mount onto the glass.





After mounting the film on the cleaned windshield glass, peel off the other cover marked "2".

STEP 2: INSTALLING THE BRACKET


Remove the film on the bracket cover. Then place it on the electrostatic film.





STEP 3: CONNECT THE CAMERA

Connect the car charger to camera's USB port and wire the cable according to the overall wiring diagram below.



IMPORTANT!

Please use the original car charger provided to avoid a fault or incompatibility.

INSTALL CAR CHARGER CABLE



Hide the cable into to the top panel as the photo



Break the side panel slightly and insert the cable. Be extra careful if there is an airbag.



Insert the cable to the door's sealing tape.



Insert the cable according to the door's sealing tape.



Insert the cable according to the door's sealing tape.



Connect the car charger to cigarette lighter.

IMPORTANT NOTES



If your vehicle has side curtain airbags please be very careful when running any cables along your vehicle windows. Ensure you are not running the cable past any of the airbags as this can prevent the airbags from deploying.

Please make sure the cigarette lighter is clean for connection.

Please check the car charger's red indicator whether is on.
